New Student Enrollment for 2023-2024

Brady ISD will be utilizing online enrollment beginning with the 2023-2024 school year. All parents/guardians must create a ParentPortal account at [ASCENDER ParentPortal Login \(esc15.net\)](https://ascenderparentportal.esc15.net) using one of three browsers Firefox, Google Chrome, or Safari.

Required documents for ALL new enrolling students in Head Start through grade 12:

- Student's Birth Certificate
- Student's Social Security Card
- Student's Current Immunization Record
- Enrolling Parent/Guardian's Driver's License
- Proof of Residency in the Brady ISD (utility bill, or mortgage or rental agreement)
- Foster 2085 (if applicable)
- Custody Paperwork (if applicable)
- Previous school transcript or withdrawal paperwork

Please Note: The above documents are needed to complete enrollment. Brady ISD Campuses will request records from previous school once the child is enrolled. If you are missing any of the above document's, enrollment may be delayed.

Pre-Kindergarten qualifiers:

1. Be unable to speak and comprehend the English language.
2. Be educationally disadvantaged, which means a student eligible to participate in the national free or reduced-price lunch program. Please see school income guidelines.
3. Be homeless, as defined by 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 1143a, regardless of the residence of the child, of either parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other person having lawful control of the child.
4. Special Assistance Program Participants—Children in households receiving benefits from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Food Distribution Program for Households on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), are eligible for free meals.
5. Be the child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority.
6. Be the child of a member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty.
7. Be in, or have been in, the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code.
8. Be the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as a peace officer (3106.002), firefighter (3106.003), or emergency medical first responder (3106.004).
