SUPT. BUDGET **INFORMATION**

Dennis Hill, Interim Superintendent, stated the educational plan of a district should be expressed in fiscal terms. He explained the proposed budget for 2019-2020 that will be presented is not as refined as desired due to HB 3 and administrator turnover including the superintendent position. Because of this there will be a greater number of budget amendments presented throughout the year. Some plans previously initiated are not in the proposed budget therefore the board will need to approve the expenses of these plans and the money will probably come from the fund balance. Enrollment is down around 40 students right now. TASB did recently conduct a staffing review for the district and the results show the district to be overstaffed in areas. This issue will be addressed because it greatly affects the budget that will be approved.

The public hearing regarding the proposed 2019-2020

Maintenance/Operations tax rate and the Interest/Sinking tax rate began at 12:21 p.m. Ms. Landry stated the M&O tax rate has been reduced from \$1.04 last year to \$0.97 for this year. The total tax rate including both M&O and I&S is down by \$0.01 from last year's total tax rate. Mr. Hill impressed for future reference that a greater amount needs to be put into Fund Balance to offset future situations. With no discussion from community members in attendance the public hearing ended at 12:27 p.m.

ADOPT DISTRICT OFFICAL M&O AND I&S TAX RATE FOR 2019-2020	Mr. Hernandez moved to adopt the Maintenance & Operations (M&O) tax rate for the 2019-2020 school year at \$0.97 per \$100 valuation and the Interest & Sinking (I&S) tax rate for the 2019-2020 school year at \$0.3279 per \$100 valuation for a total tax rate of \$1.2979 per recommendation by Mr. Hill, seconded by Mr. Raybion and the motion carried 5-0.
SUPT. CLOSING COMMENTS	Mr. Hill suggested for future public budget hearings possibly conduct them immediately before the regular board meeting in August. This may mean moving the regular board meeting from the third Monday of the month to a date that would fit the time frame for the budget hearing requirement. The public hearing would need to be posted separately from the regular meeting but the adoption of the proposed budget and tax rates could then be conducted in the regular meeting. This would eliminate the board having to meet multiple times in a short frame of time and gives them a better chance of all being in attendance.
ADJOURN	Mr. Bierman moved that the meeting be adjourned at 12:31 p.m., seconded by Mr. Raybion and the motion carried 5-0.
